## CANADIAN CORPORATION REAFFIRMS INTEREST IN THE HOSPITAL OF EXCELLENCE PROJECT IN CHICLAYO

January 29, 2020

\* REQUEST INFORMATION FROM THE REGIONAL GOVERNOR TO DEFINE A CONCEPTUAL PROPOSAL AND PREPARE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING.



The company MINAEAN SP Construction Corporation from Vancouver, Canada, reaffirmed its interest in the development of the Hospital of Excellence Project for the Province of Chiclayo that will benefit the most vulnerable population in the region.



Mervyn Pinto, president of the corporation in a letter addressed to the regional governor of Lambayeque, Lic. Anselmo Lozano, on January 27, 2020, said that the memorandum of understanding is being worked on to structure and finalize the process of development and financing of the project.

Likewise, in order to prepare a conceptual proposal and economic aspects, it required additional information on infrastructure facilities, population density, available health services, types of diseases, types of insurance and coverage and description of the infrastructure for clinical operations and the support that needs to be developed.

As recalled by Regional Agreement No. 123-2019-GR.LAMB / GR, the Lambayeque Regional Council declared of interest and regional priority the construction and equipment of the Hospital of Excellence for Chiclayo, this project, according to the proposal, this will be executed on a government-to-government modality.

It should be noted that this hospital is of utmost importance due to the deficient infrastructure of some regional hospitals, which no longer have the capacity to meet the great health demand of patients from Tumbes, Piura, La Libertad, Cajamarca, Amazonas, San Martín and Loreto.

The Hospital of Excellence would have a capacity of 400 to 600 beds, with modern technology and specialized personnel.
